

St. Bridget's RC Primary School

Challenge

Current research shows that the majority of a child's learning takes place out of school, so St. Bridget's vision was to influence and support that out of school learning through technology. With the financial support of school and parents, the children's learning was personalised by the introduction of an individual UMPC for every child, every day. St. Bridget's has a 30% FSM quotient.



Solution

Every child was given a device that would belong to them 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. In conjunction with the eLearning Foundation, the HomeWorks team at PC World Education supplied St. Bridget's with 30 Samsung Q1 tablets with 3 years Warranty, 3 years Accidental Damage and Theft Insurance, External keyboard, extended life battery, carry case, MS Office and Childnet's 'Know I.T. All' Parental Software loaded, prior to delivery to St. Bridget's.



Outcome

St. Bridget's has successfully integrated the Samsung Q1's into Year 6's curriculum as a powerful, enabling learning tool and after only one term, the school reports highly motivated and engaged learners, all for 33p per day or £10 per month. The School Head succeeded in securing 100% participation in parental support and donations.
